### SUMMER CHILDREN’S AND TEEN’S ART PROGRAM:

Inspiration in Art was the theme for the art programs that began on July 9th and ended on July 20th, 2018 with an exhibit of student work. Family, friends and the public were invited to see the

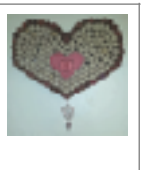

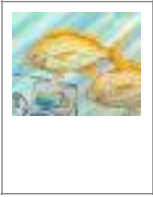

The process involves applying oil based inks directly to the fish then natural fiber or fabric is placed on top of the fish and rubbed. Various techniques and bold colors are used to transform this traditional process into a unique fish print for each participant to take home. For those that have taken previous workshops more advanced techniques will be explained. Students are also welcome to bring their own tee shirts (light colors in cotton or cotton blends are best). 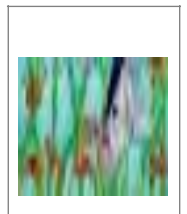

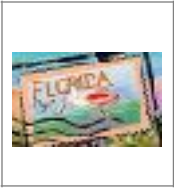

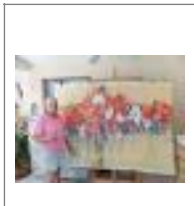
