Participant Instructions

Guidelines for Inclusion of ART in Art Sale

- Art and Craft Items ONLY – No commercially made items or other garage sale items
- Prints OK – framed or unframed (if unframed, must be packaged for sale)
- Framed 2D work must be ready to hang
- No damaged items
- **All items to be sold must be marked with Member Name, Description, and Price – ATTACHED TO THE ARTWORK. “Last Gasp” Art Supply Items to be donated do not have to be labeled (see below).**
- Keyhole will total all items sold at the Art Sale and distribute a single check to the CKAC around June 15 along with a list of all sales identifying the CKAC Member ID #.
- CKAC will receive 25% of the final sale price, member to receive 75% unless full donation specified on form.
- CKAC will distribute individual checks to members in the last two weeks of June. Credit Card Sales Charges will be deducted from the CKAC 25% commission. **(a detailed inventory of what was sold vs donated will not be provided but records will be kept for reference if there is an inquiry)**
- CKAC Board reserves the right to reject items to be placed in Art Sale.
- CKAC Members will sign a waiver stating that they understand that Art items are not insured.
- Functional Art Equipment (Easels, Grinders, Tools and UNUSED/UNOPENED art supplies may be placed on sale. Large equipment (Kiln, Saws, etc) may be sold after consultation with Mary or Bev (a flyer will be prepared for approved items and posted with CKAC Member’s contact information – any sales subject to pricing guidelines below. Honor system).
- The Member Artist Gallery will be labeled “Last Gasp Gallery” for partially used or well used art supplies that members would like to donate to the CKAC. Donations suggested (CKAC and CAP have first dibs on these items)

Pricing Guidelines

- Items should be PRICED TO SELL (bargain)
- 25% of the Sale price will go to the CKAC or Member can elect to donate all proceeds to CKAC.
- In addition, members must agree to having items marked down by 25% after 2 weeks, and 50% of original price after 3 weeks. (this will not be advertised but should be considered when the items is priced)
- Members have the choice to donate all proceeds to the CKAC and must agree that if their items are not picked up by 5 pm on the last day of the sale that it will be assumed that they are donating any remaining items.
